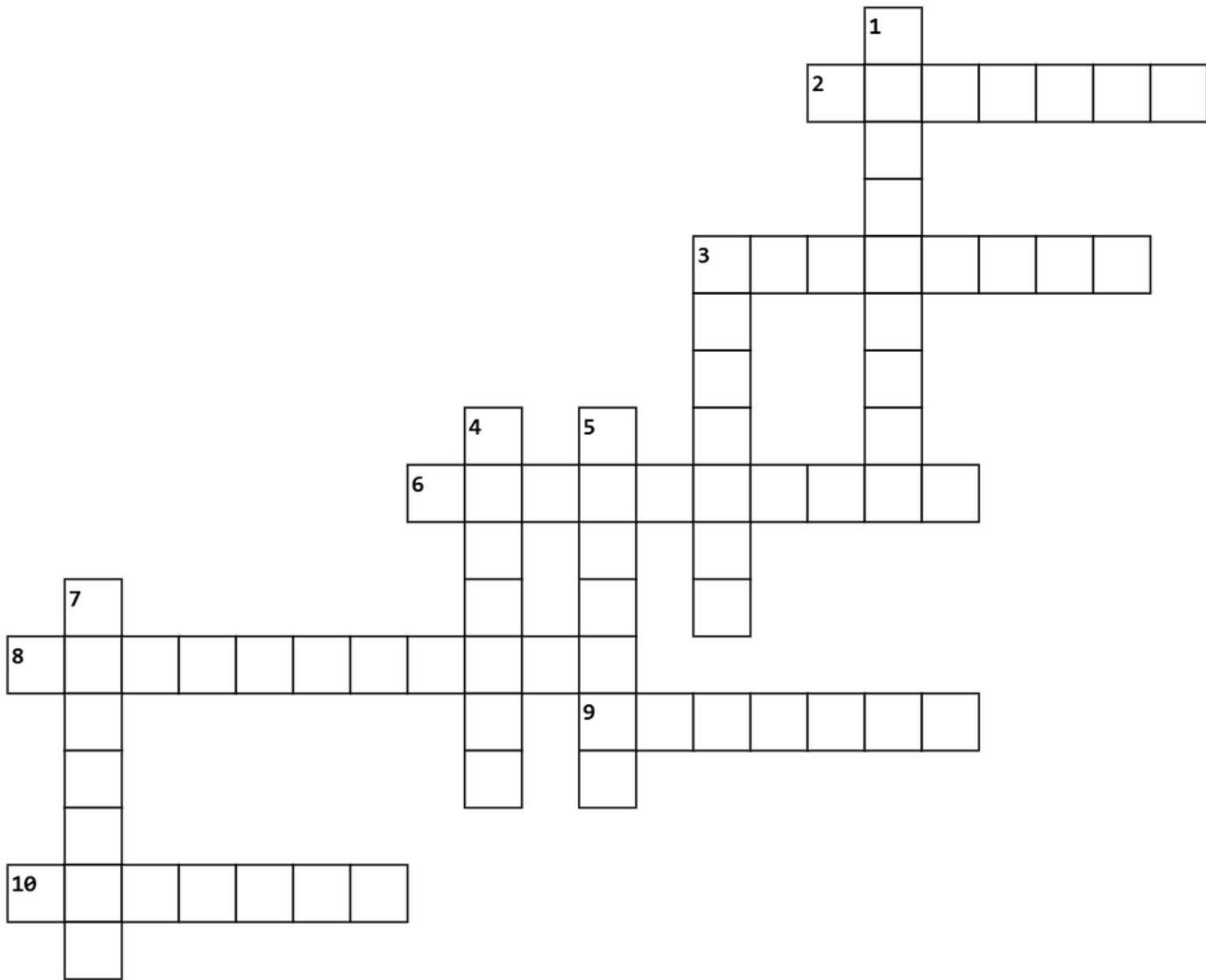

10. To join two things together, like matching puzzle pieces. (7 letters)

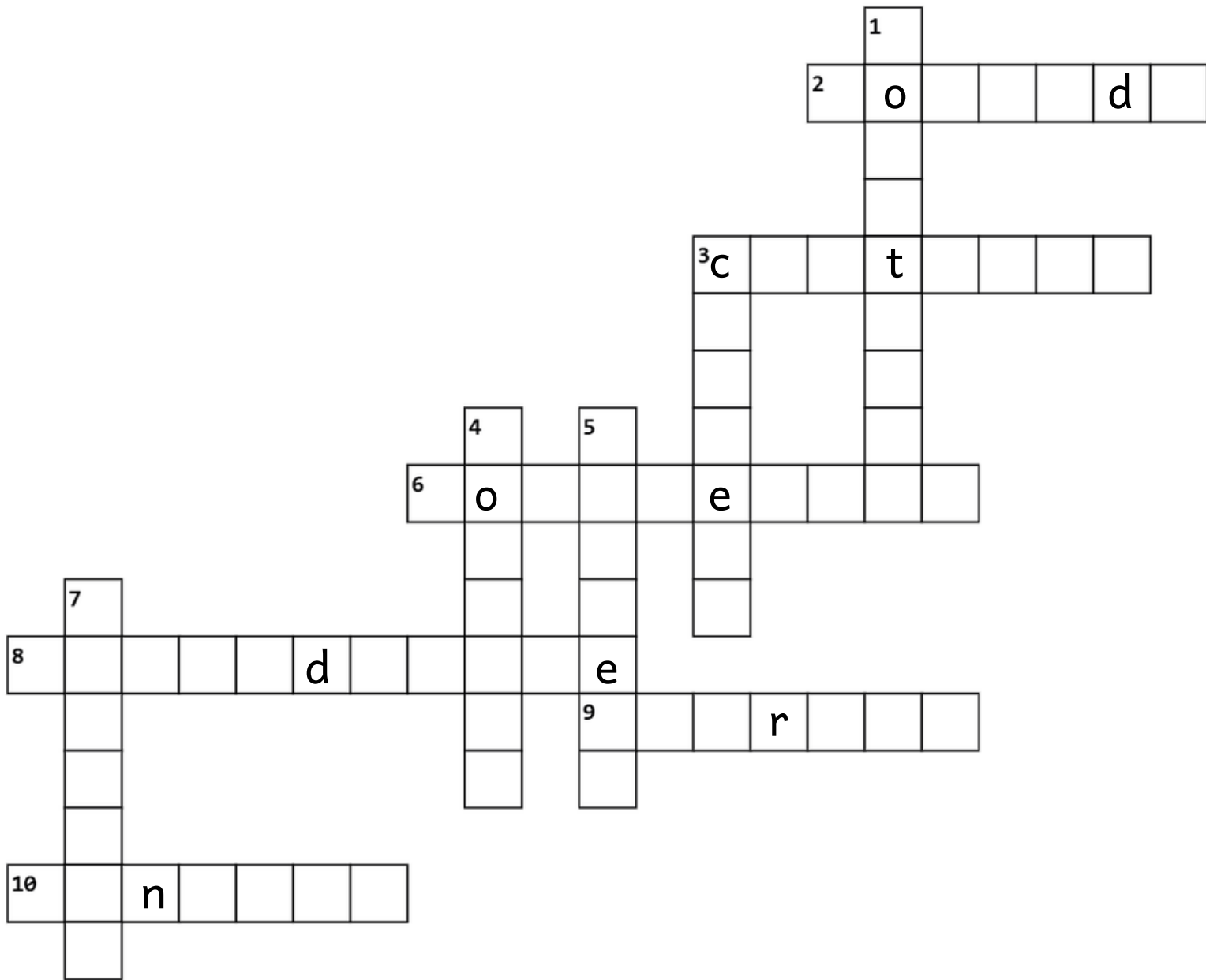


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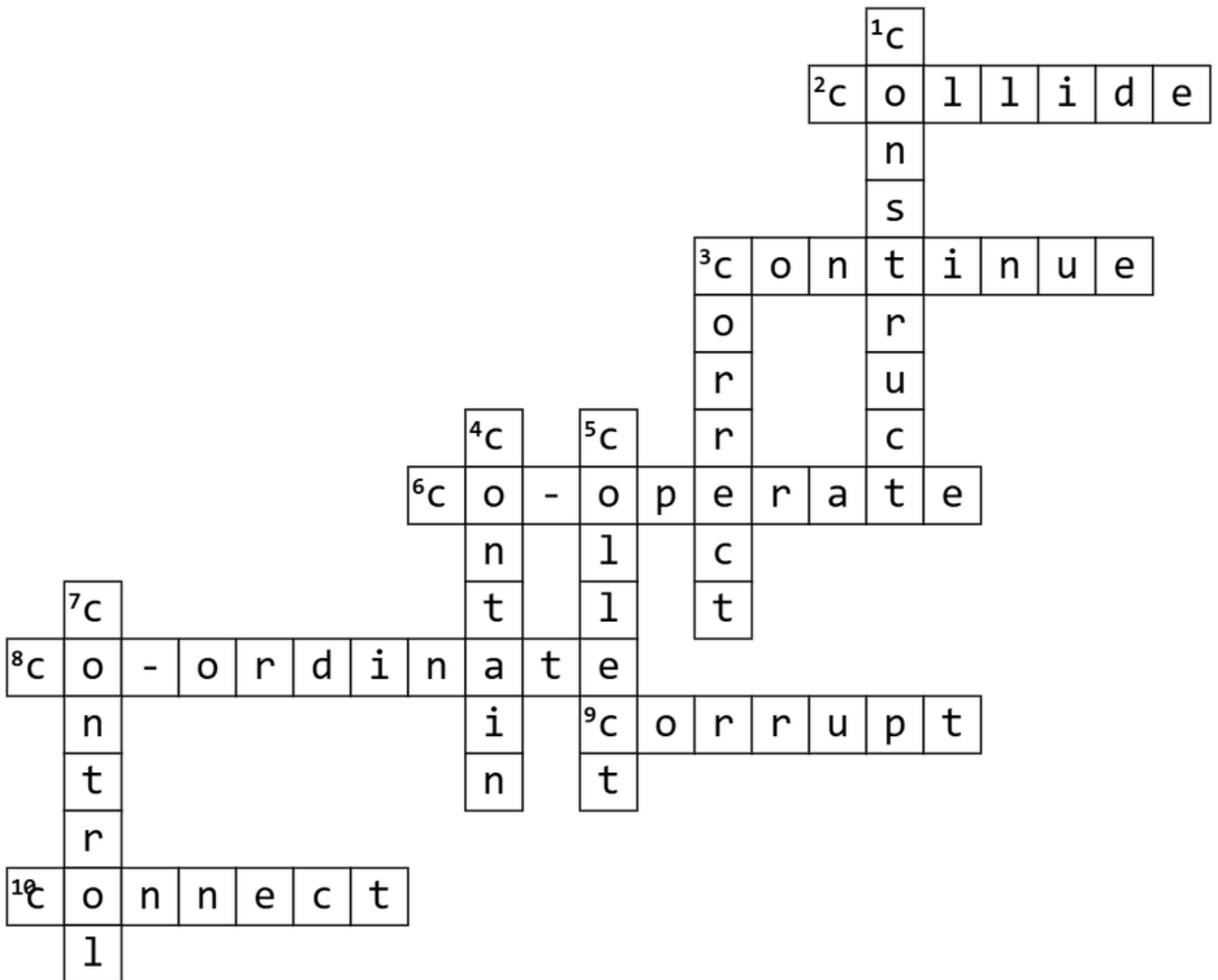


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
