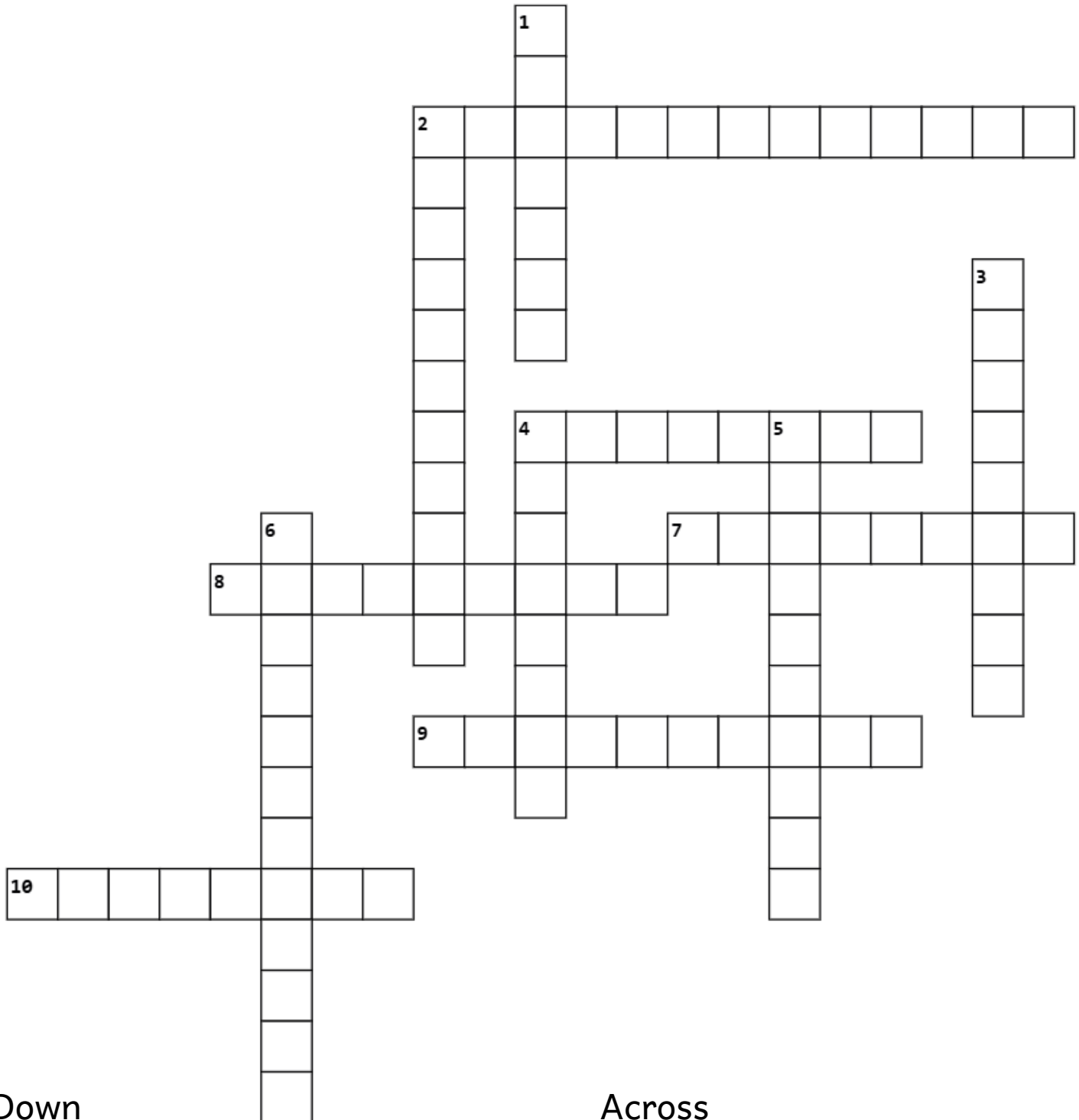

10. A clever person who can speak lots of different languages. (8 letters)

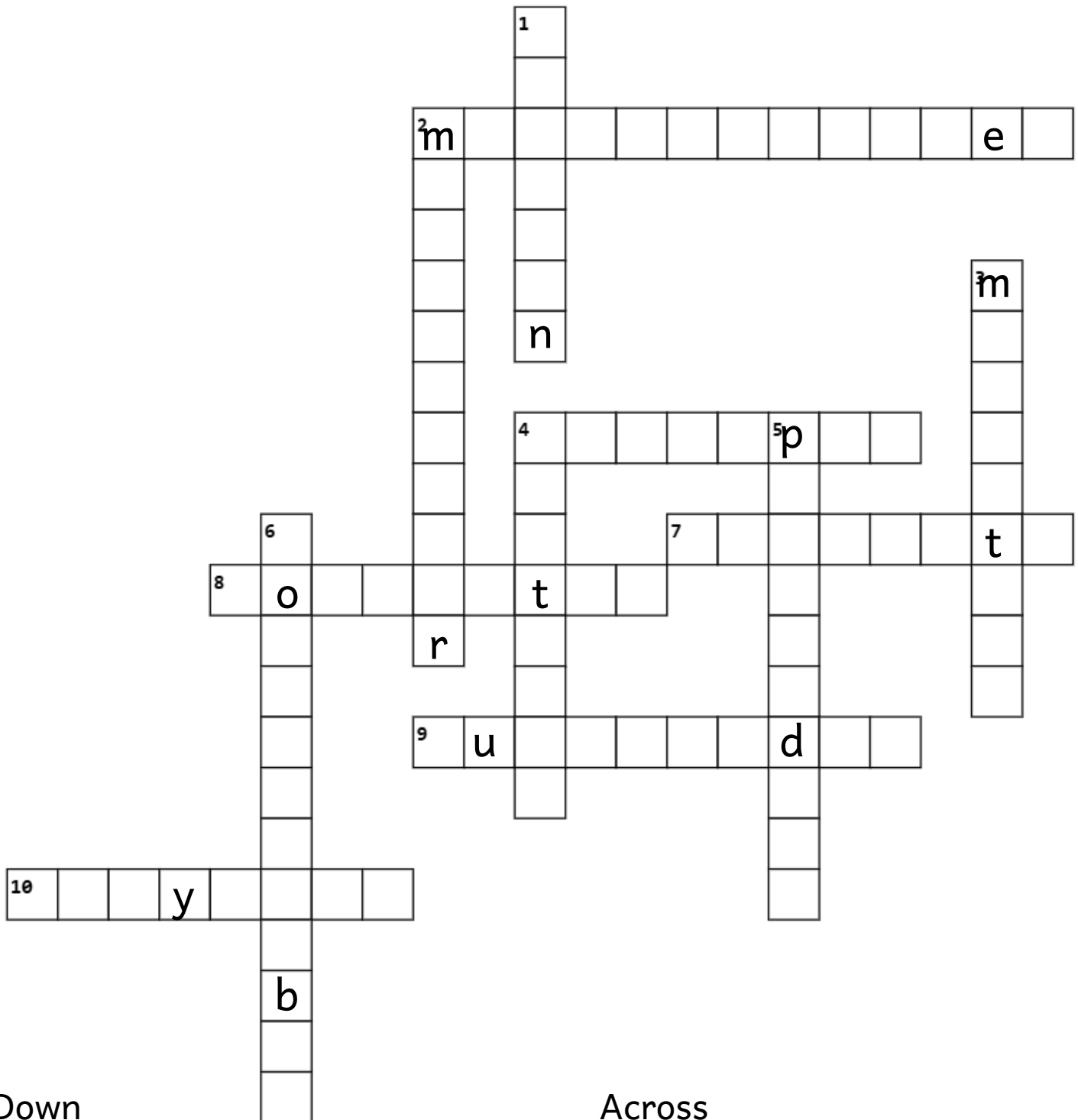


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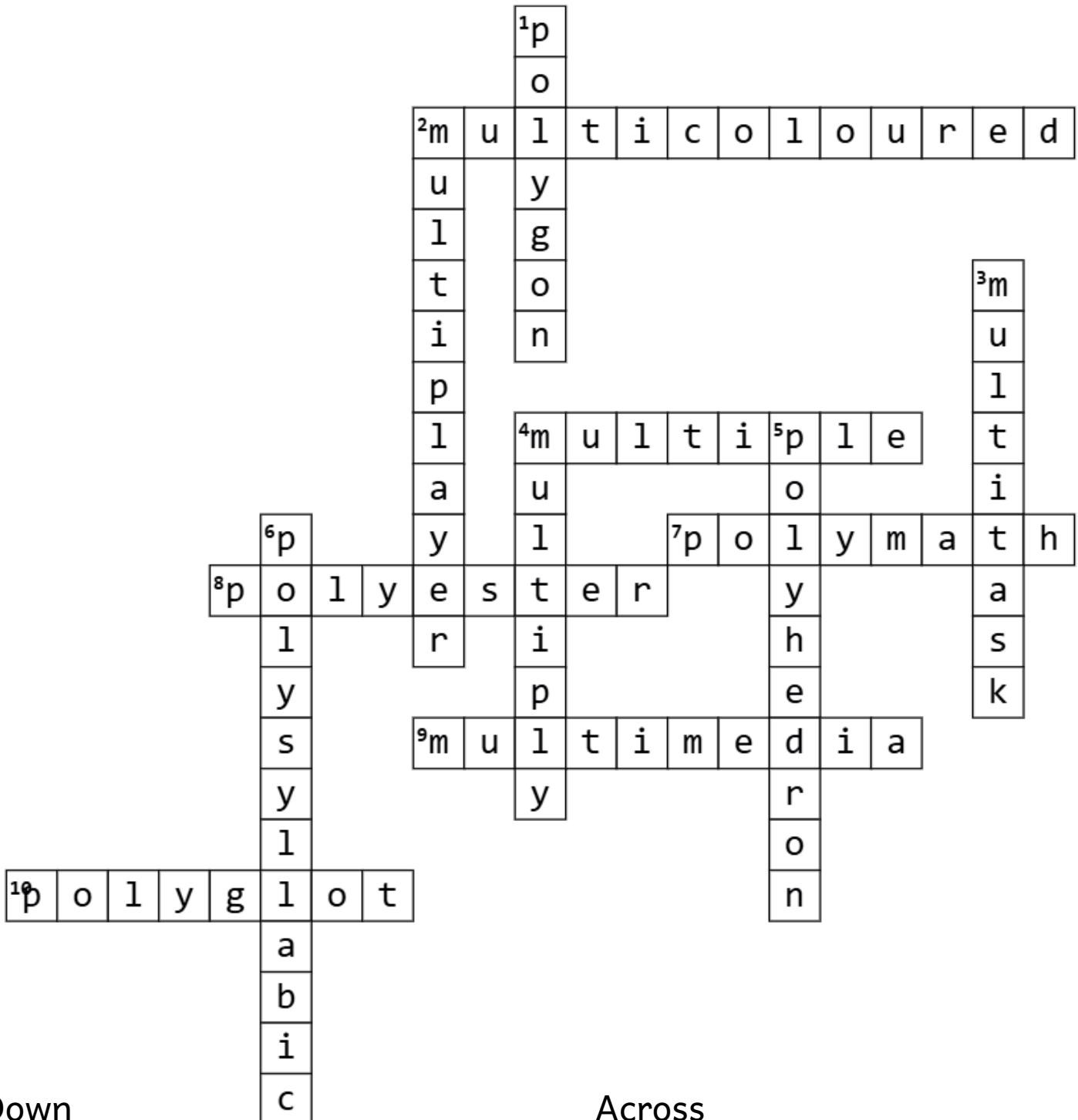
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
