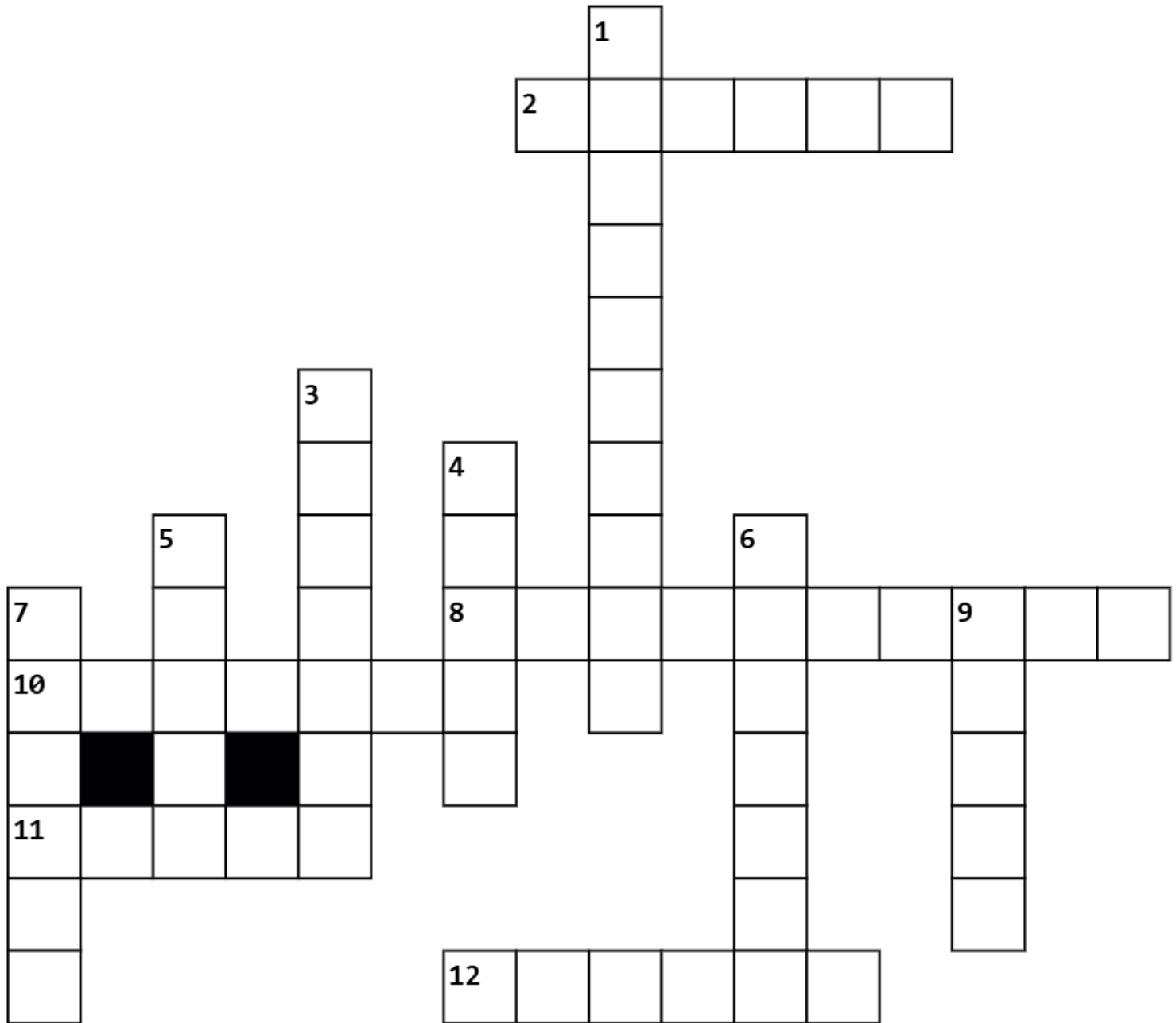

12. To push or drive an object forward through the air or water. (6 letters)

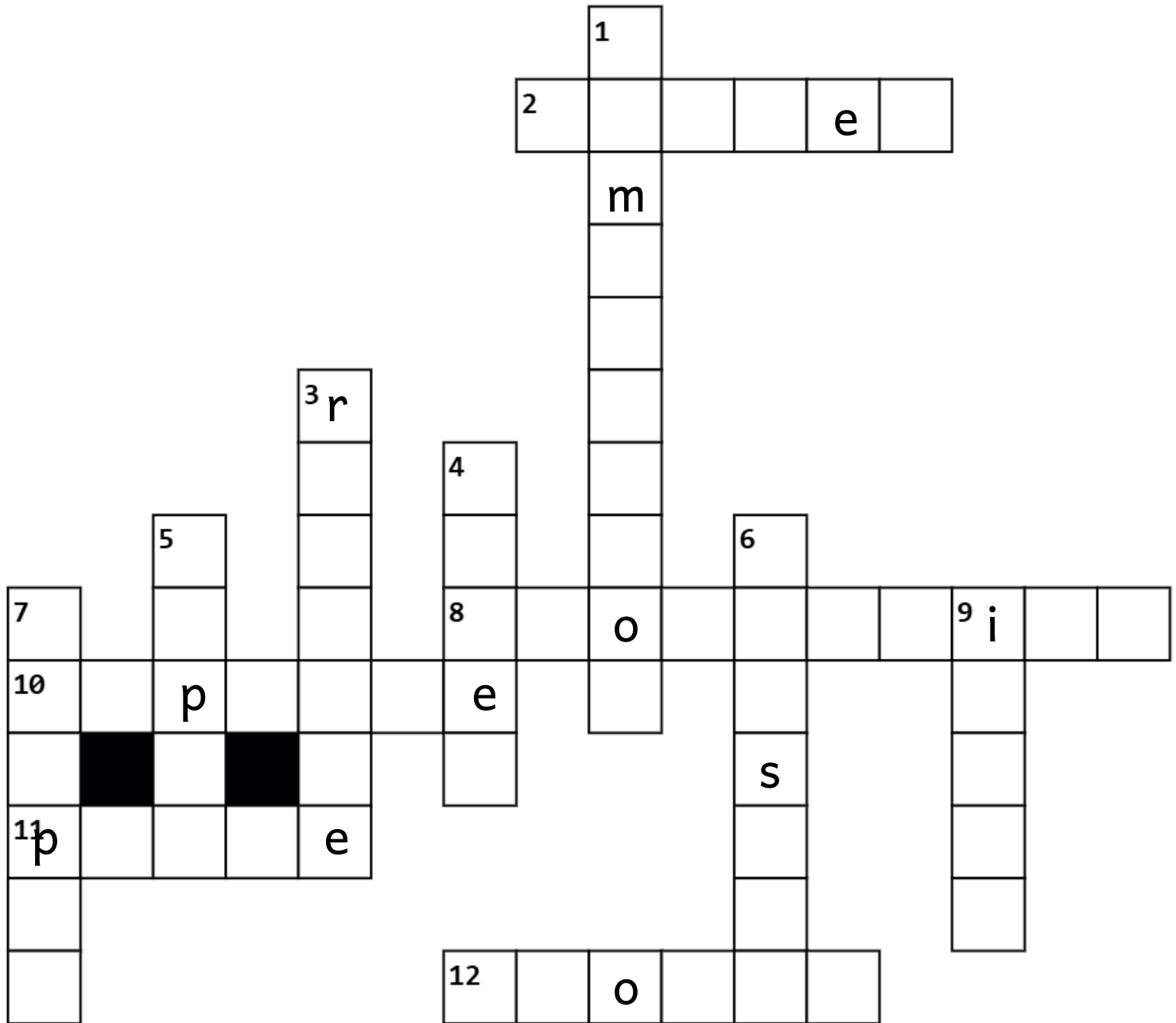


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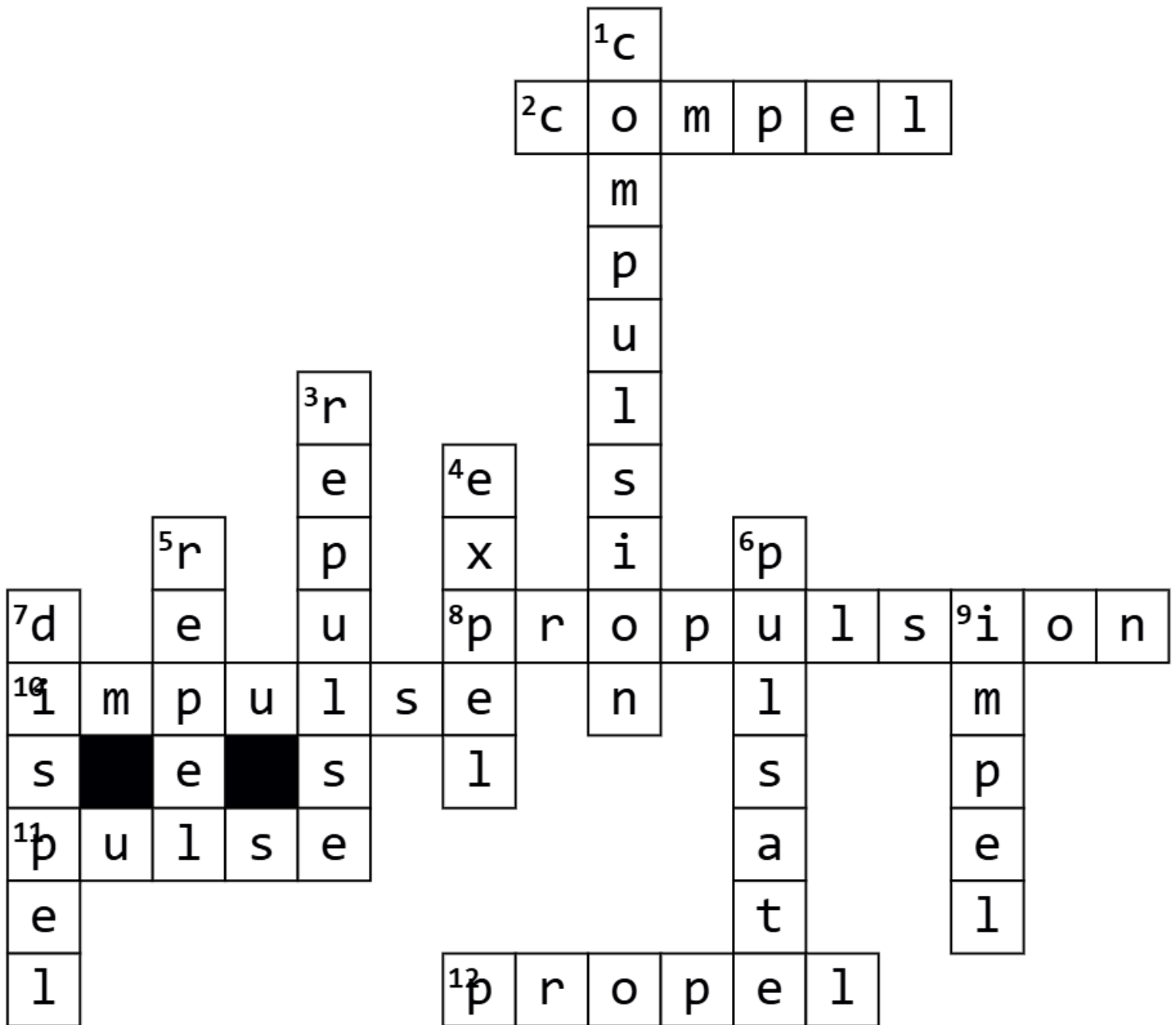


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
