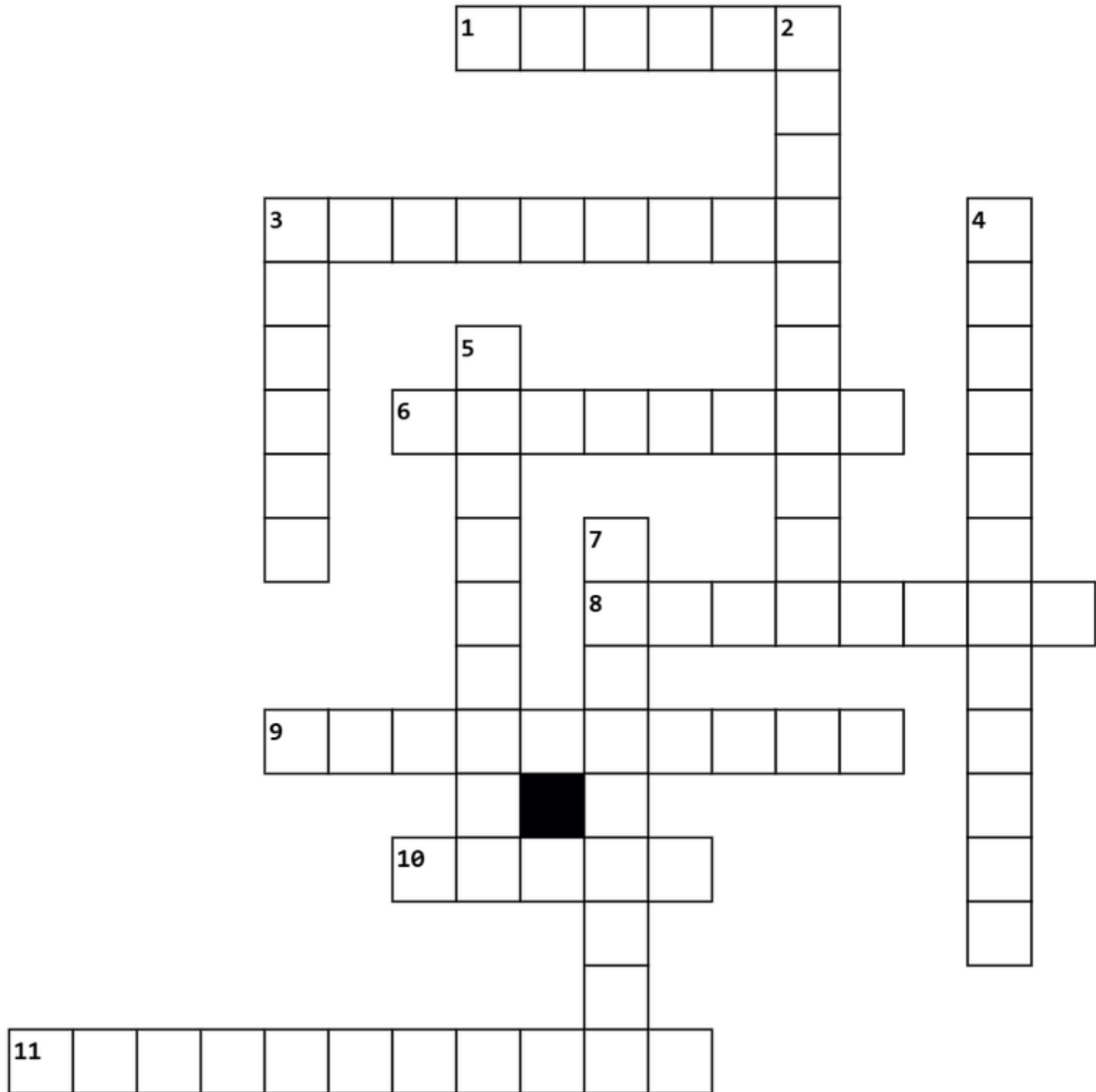

11. A tool used to check your temperature to see if you have a fever. (11 letters)

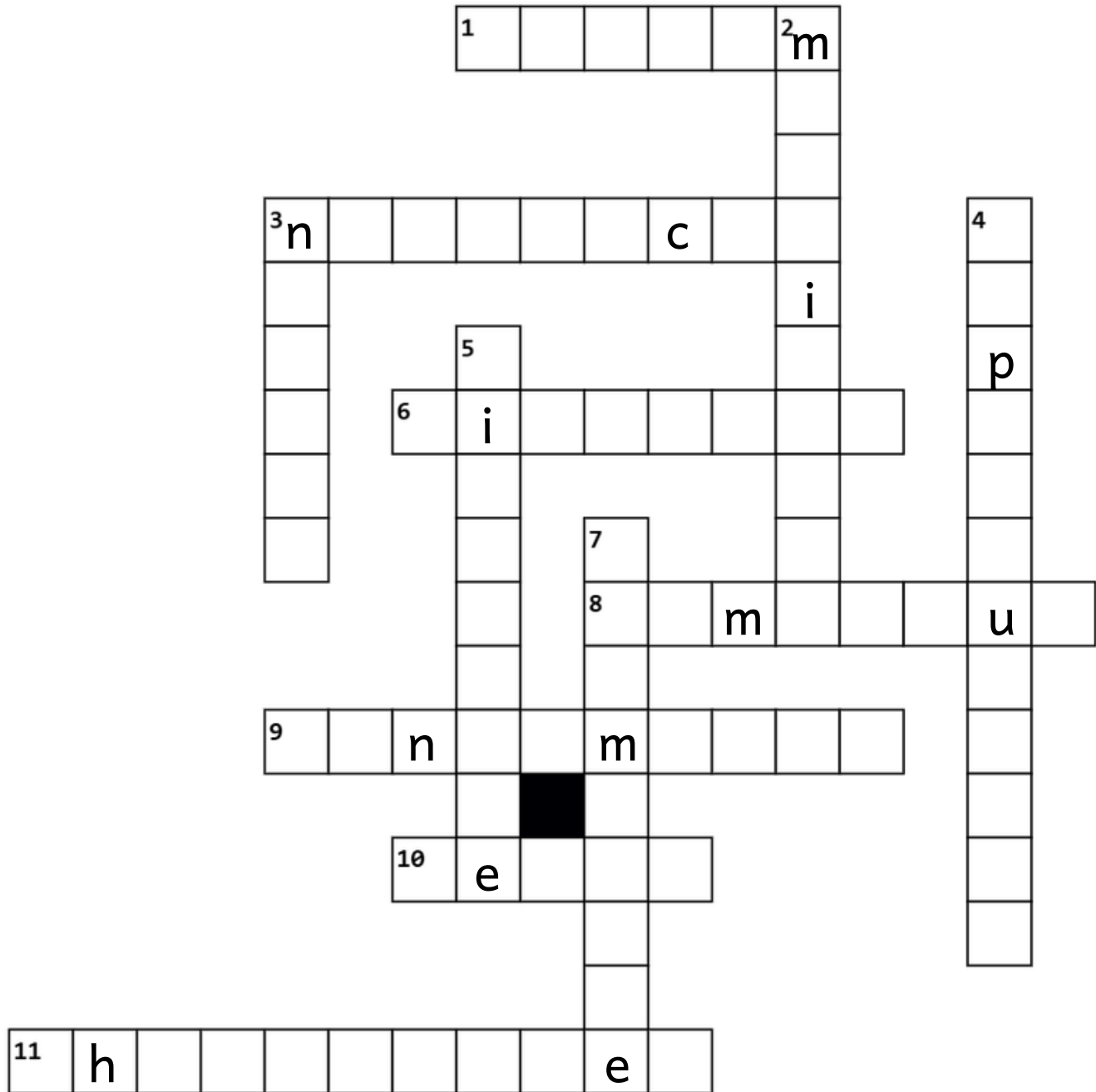


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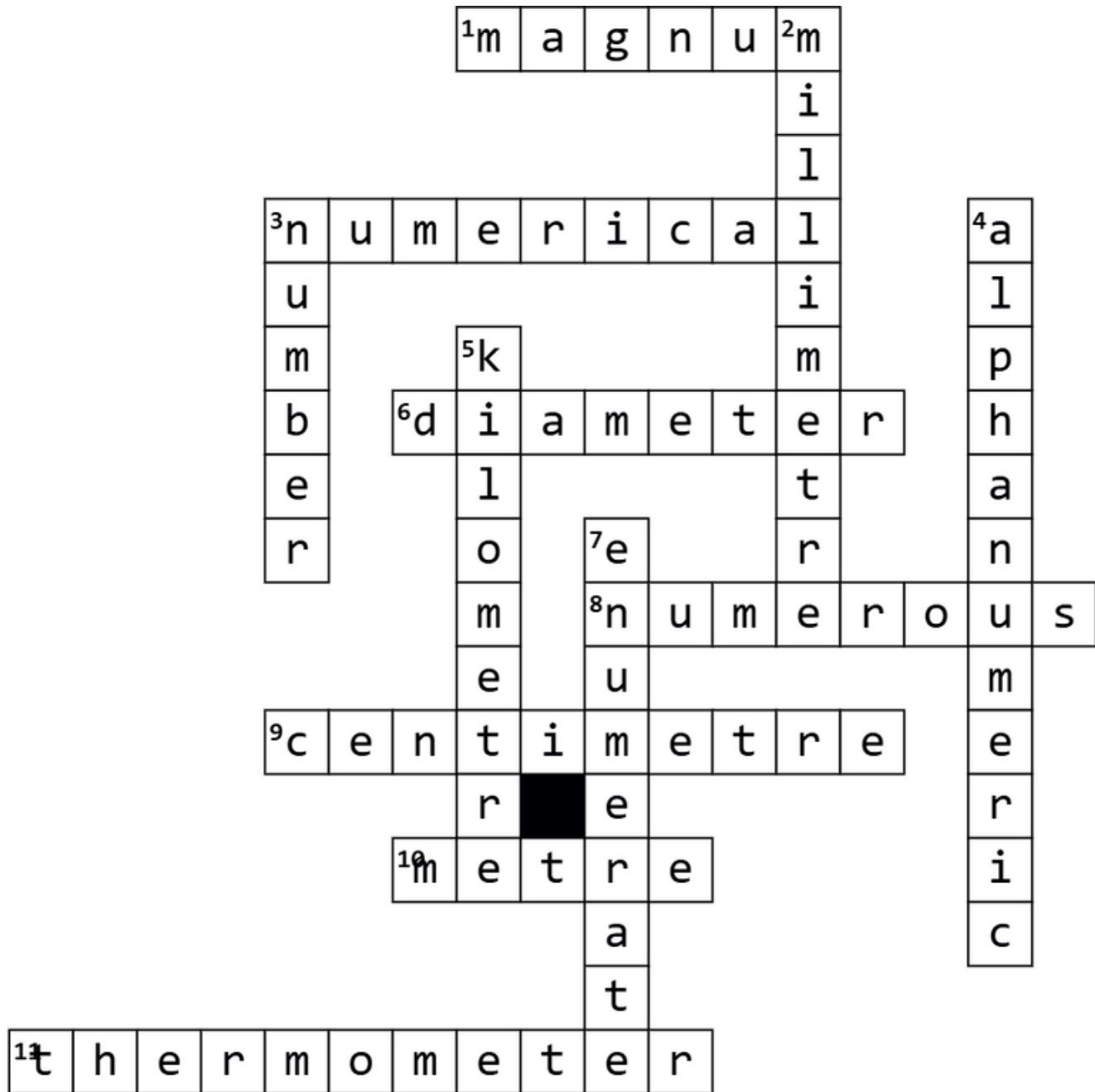


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
