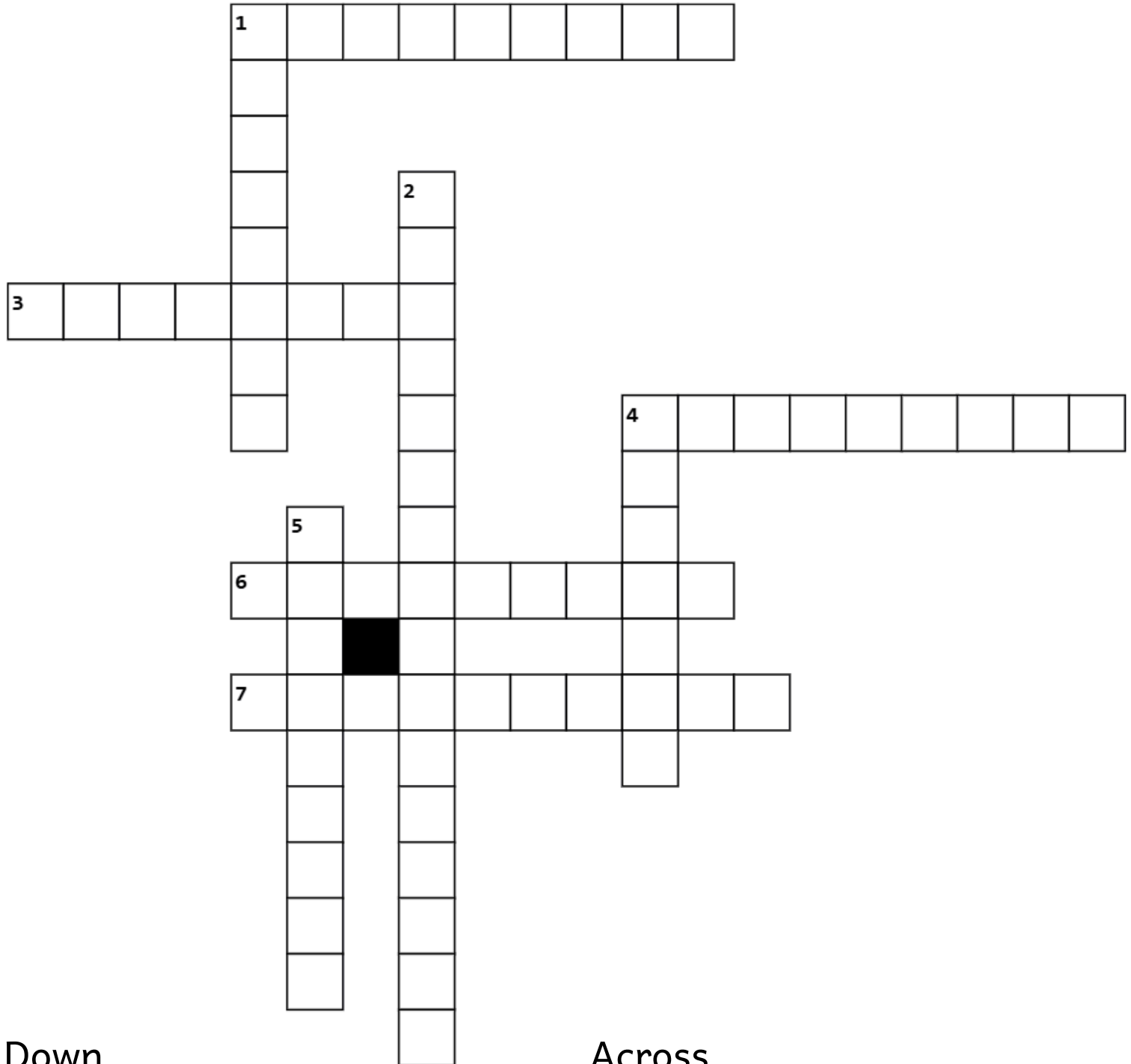

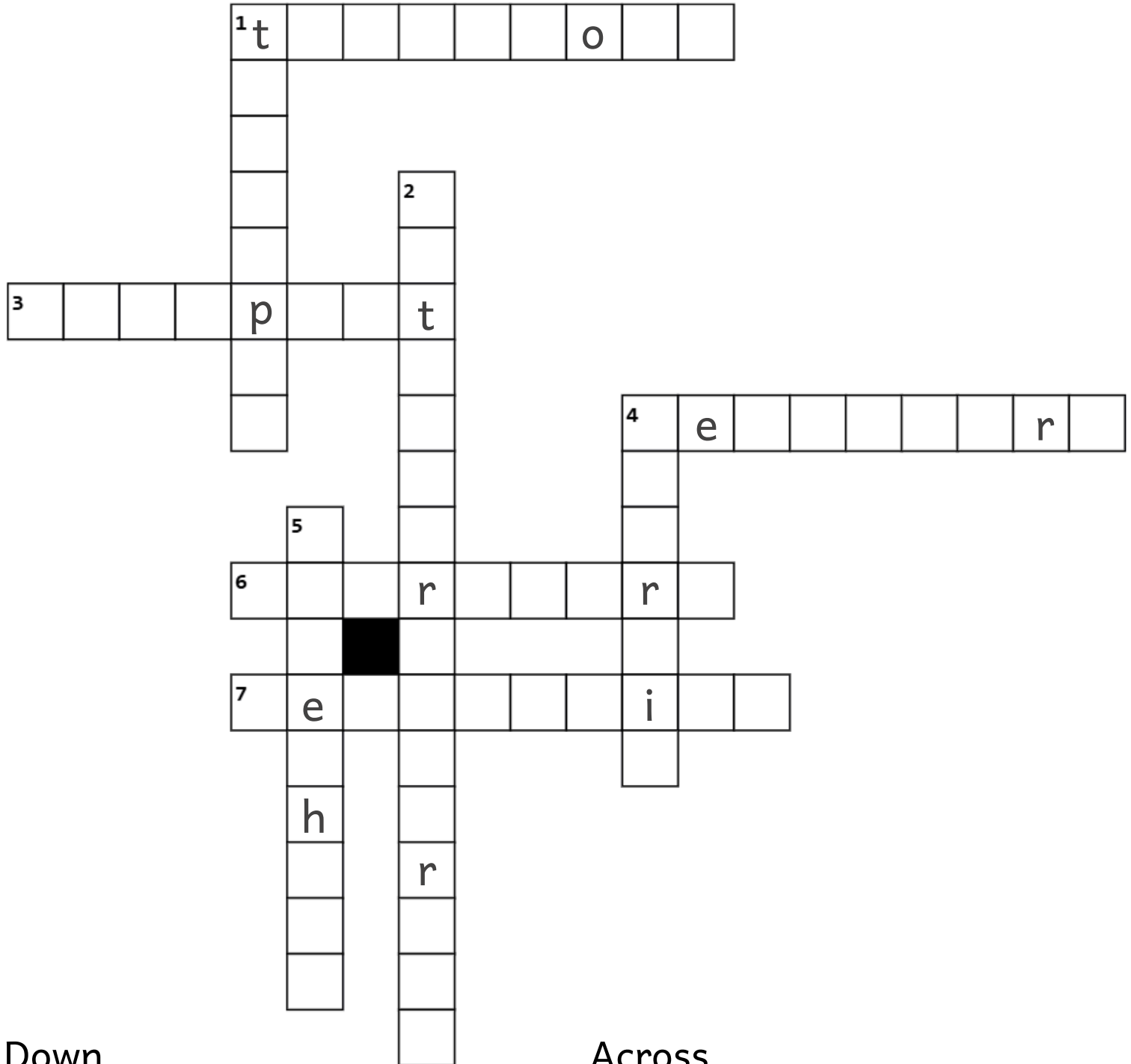
1. A long tube used to look at the moon and distant stars in the night sky. (9 letters)

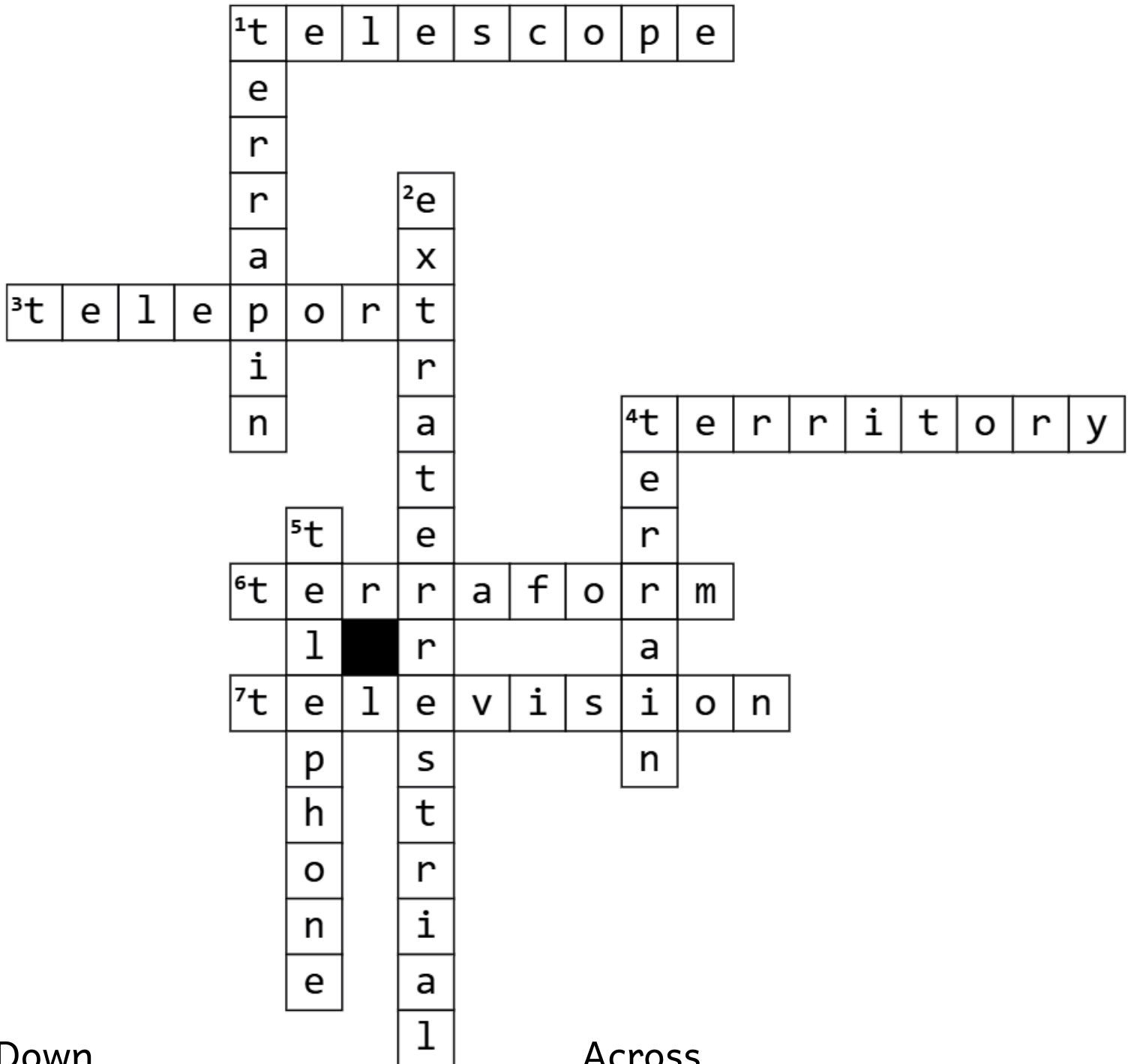
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
